The interpretations of the nakshatras that are given below are modern renditions of the ancient Vedic system of interpreting. Much of the ancient astrological interpretations are written in a fatalistic language that most contemporary western astrologers believe needs to be updated to a more modern and psychologically oriented language. The interpretations given below are a slightly more modern and psychological version of the ancient interpretations of the nakshatras, and still include much of the original Vedic ideas on how the nakshatra influences you.

Nakshatras are also known as lunar mansions. There are 27 nakshatras, and each one has a length of 13 degrees and 20 minutes.

The Moon is in Krithika, the third nakshatra (26 deg 40 min of Aries to 10 deg of Taurus). Most likely you are a heavy eater, fond of the society of matrons, and others may have suspicions about your moral conduct. You are brilliant and may be famous.
